On November 7, 2007, the following letter was sent to Mr. Brent Rich:

This is to notify you that the Superintendent of Schools will be recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of November 20, 2007, that the School Board suspend you without pay from your current position as Security Monitor at Miami Beach Senior High School, for 30 workdays, effective at the close of the workday, November 20, 2007, for just cause, including, but not limited to: misconduct in office; and violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13- 4-1.09, Employee-Student Relationships, and 6Gx13- 4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 1001.32(2), 1012.22(1)(f), 1012.40, and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

If the School Board accepts (or approves) the Superintendent's recommendation, you will be notified of the School Board's action.

You have waived, in writing, your right to contest your suspension.

RECOMMENDED: That effective November 20, 2007, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend Mr. Brent Rich, Security Monitor at Miami Beach Senior High School, for 30 workdays without pay.
