 CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT FOR A TERM OF FIVE YEARS**

As established in School Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.471, Charter Schools (K-12), Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) has received charter school applications from individuals and/or organizations in the community.

On October 30, 2007, M-DCPS Charter School District Review Committee met to review the application for Life Skills Center – Northwest Miami and by a unanimous vote made a recommendation for approval of the application to the Superintendent of Schools.

The charter school proposes to serve a maximum of 500 “at-risk” students in grades nine through twelve, with a maximum of 250 students in its first year of operation, commencing with the 2008-2009 school year and continuing throughout the term of the contract which ends on June 30, 2013, and concludes in the 2012-2013 school year.

Following is the Governing Board for the charter school: Ms. Alicia Rodriguez Bower, Former Charter School Principal; Mr. Jose Antonio Loreda, Attorney; Ms. Judy Salvador, Volunteer; and Ms. Dannie McMillon, Child Advocate.

The charter school contractual agreement will be submitted for School Board consideration at a subsequent meeting at which time there will be a public hearing to provide for community input.

Copies of the application will be transmitted to the School Board Members under separate cover and will be available for inspection by the public in the Office of Board Recording Secretary, Room 924, and in the Citizen Information Center, Room 158, 1450 NE Second Avenue, Miami, Florida 33132.
