As established in School Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.471, Charter Schools (K-12), Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) has received charter school applications from individuals and/or organizations in the community.

On November 21, 2007, M-DCPS Charter School District Review Committee met to review the application for Advanced Learning Charter School and by a unanimous vote made a recommendation for approval of the application to the Superintendent of Schools.

The charter school proposes to serve a maximum of 350 students in grades kindergarten through five, with a maximum of 250 students in its first year of operation, commencing with the 2008-2009 school year and continuing throughout the term of the contract, which ends on June 30, 2013, and concludes in the 2012-2013 school year.

Following is the Founding Board for the charter school: Mr. Hector Urbistondo, Attorney, Urbi & Associates; Ms. Ivette Diaz, President, Child Care Consultant, Inc.; and Mr. Alberto Perez, Operations Manager, Caremark.

The charter school contractual agreement will be submitted for School Board consideration at a subsequent meeting at which time there will be a public hearing to provide for community input.

Copies of the application will be transmitted to the School Board Members under separate cover and will be available for inspection by the public in the Office of Board Recording Secretary, Room 924, and in the Citizen Information Center, Room 158, 1450 NE Second Avenue, Miami, Florida 33132.

1. approve the application for Advanced Learning Charter School, Inc., on behalf of Advanced Learning Charter School; and
2. authorize the Superintendent to negotiate a charter school contractual agreement for a term of five years, commencing with the 2008-2009 school year and continuing throughout the term of the contract, which ends on June 30, 2013, and concludes in the 2012-2013 school year, which reflects the contents of the application as approved by the School Board.
