Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) has concluded its successful 2007 United Way campaign, with total contributions reaching \$2,607,129. The employee campaign raised \$1,780,041, and the student campaign raised \$827,088. The District had the most successful school district campaign in the nation again this year, and continues to be the only institution with a campaign of more than \$2,000,000, in Miami-Dade County.

Under the theme of "It Takes Caring," all of the District's labor unions and bargaining units participated in the United Way campaign and were instrumental in its success. The participation of M-DCPS employees, students, labor unions and bargaining units in the United Way of Miami-Dade campaign is in keeping with the school system's long-standing support of United Way, which in turn funds more than 100 community programs that provide social services that help thousands of men, women, and children in Miami-Dade County.
