SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF MIAMI FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FOOD AND NUTRITION TO PROVIDE MEALS FOR PARTICIPANTS IN THE CITY'S SUMMER CAMP PROGRAMS FROM JUNE 9, 2008 THROUGH AUGUST 1, 2008

The Superintendent of Schools requests authorization to enter into a contractual agreement with the City of Miami for the Department of Food and Nutrition to provide meals for participants in the City's summer camp program.

The School Food Service Accounting Department will bill the City of Miami, for each lunch and snack provided at a cost of \$2.60 per lunch and \$.60 per snack. The price charged for the summer meals and snacks covers the total cost of summer meal service by Miami-Dade County Public Schools including food, meal preparation, supplies and delivery.

The United States Department of Agriculture directs summer organizations to use School Food Service Authorities as the providers for meal services stating in federal regulation 7CFR Part 225.15(b) (1). "Each sponsor shall, to the maximum extent feasible, utilize either its own food service facilities or obtain meals from a school food service facility, the applicable requirements of this part shall be embodied in a written agreement between the sponsor and the school."

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent of Schools to enter into a contractual agreement with the City of Miami for the Department of Food and Nutrition to provide meals for participants in the City's summer camp programs from June 9, 2008 through August 1, 2008.
