On January 16, 2008, the Board commissioned the firm of Biscayne Engineering Company, Inc. (Biscayne Engineering), to provide Land Surveying Consultant services, with a four-year contract. According to documentation provided to staff, Biscayne Engineering requests the Board's permission to replace George Bolton, President, with Michael Bartholomew, Vice President, as the designated Principal because Mr. Bolton is often away from the Miami-Dade area, which could have an impact on services provided to the Board.

Should the Board approve this request, the Land Surveying Services Consultant agreement with Biscayne Engineering will be amended to reflect the designated Principal change. All other terms and conditions of the agreement would remain the same.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, approve the replacement of George Bolton with Michael Bartholomew as designated Principal of the firm of Biscayne Engineering Company, Inc.
