SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION TO EXERCISE THE SECOND-YEAR OPTION OF THE FOUR-YEAR AGREEMENT WITH ENHEALTH ENVIRONMENTAL, INC., TO PROVIDE ENVIRONMENTAL CONSULTING AND TESTING SERVICES AS AN ALTERNATE / QUALITY CONTROL CONSULTANT

On July 11, 2007, the Board commissioned Enhealth Environmental, Inc. (EEI), to provide Environmental Consulting and Testing Services for a four-year term, with the second, third and fourth years at the option of the Board.

The Agreement provides for a four (4) year term commencing July 11, 2007 and expiring July 10, 2011 under the same terms and conditions. The second-year option will begin on July 12, 2008, and expire on July 11, 2009.

To date, for the first year of the current Agreement, a total of \$6,080 has been invoiced and paid to EEI, for professional services rendered.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent, or his designee, to exercise the second-year option with Enhealth Environmental, Inc., to provide Environmental Consulting and Testing Services as an Alternate / Quality Control Consultant under the same terms and conditions.
