SUBJECT: REQUEST SCHOOL BOARD APPROVAL OF THE CHARTER SCHOOL CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH INTEGRATED SCIENCE AND ASIAN CULTURE ACADEMY, INC., ON BEHALF OF INTEGRATED SCIENCE AND ASIAN CULTURE ACADEMY

Section 1002.33(7), Florida Statutes, Charter Schools, requires that the major issues involved in the operation of charter schools be considered in advance and written into a charter school contractual agreement, between the charter school and the sponsor, following a public hearing to ensure community input.

On December 19, 2007, The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, approved a charter school application submitted for Integrated Science and Asian Culture Academy (ISAAC) and authorized the Superintendent to negotiate a charter school contractual agreement with the applicant for a term of ten years.

ISAAC will be located at 2450 NW 97 Avenue, Doral, Florida, 33172, and will serve a maximum of 900 students in kindergarten through grade eight, commencing with the 2008-2009 school year. The term of contract shall be for ten years, ending on June 30, 2018.

The Governing Board of the charter school is comprised of the following members: Dr. Hui Fang Huang (Angie) Su, Professor, Nova Southeastern University; Dr. Judith S. Stein, Director of the National Institute for Educational Options, Nova Southeastern University; Dr. Jim C. Han, Professor, Florida Atlantic University; and Dr. Yan Yong, Professor, Florida Atlantic University.

Section 7(b) of School Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.471, Charter Schools (K-12), stipulates that charter school contractual agreements that fully conform to the approved Standard Charter School Contract do not require review and recommendation by the Charter School Contract Review Committee and can be forwarded directly to the School Board for consideration.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, approve the charter school contractual agreement with Integrated Science and Asian Culture Academy, Inc., on behalf of Integrated Science and Asian Culture Academy for a term of ten years, commencing with the 2008-2009 school year and ending on June 30, 2018.
