REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT THREE GRANT AWARDS FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (FLDOE) FOR FUNDING THE FLORIDA DIAGNOSTIC AND LEARNING RESOURCES SYSTEM (FDLRS) ASSOCIATE CENTERS UNDER THE INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES EDUCATION ACT (IDEA), PART B; IDEA, PART B, PRESCHOOL; AND GENERAL REVENUE; AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MONROE COUNTY, FLORIDA

IMPROVE RETURN ON INVESTMENT OF GRANT DOLLARS

Authorization is requested to accept three entitlement grant awards from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) in the approximate total amount of \$1,790,789, to fund the Florida Diagnostic and Learning Resources System (FDLRS) Associate Centers Project for the grant period of July 1, 2008, through August 31, 2009, for Federal funds, and July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009 for State General Revenue Funds. The project provides a network to facilitate the provision of instruction and technology services to exceptional students and their parents and to facilitate locating and identifying children, from birth through age 21, with disabilities or children who are at risk of developing special needs, serving Miami-Dade and Monroe counties. As the fiscal agent for FDLRS-South, Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) will enter into a contractual agreement with The School Board of Monroe County, Florida, to provide services to Monroe County Public Schools, valued at an amount not to exceed \$181,000. Since 1979, M-DCPS has received the FLDOE grants in support of FDLRS. The grants will be managed by the FDLRS-South Project Manager and will be overseen by the Office of Special Education and Psychological Services. These support the District's goal of ensuring achievement of high academic standards by all students.

The FDLRS Associate Centers Project was established through the enactment of Section 1006.03, Florida Statutes. FDLRS provides diagnostic and instructional support services to District special education programs and families of students with exceptionalities statewide.

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FDLRS supports the State Performance Plan (SPP), and the state education goals of high student achievement, safe schools, and the cultivation of a high performing workforce. FDLRS activities and projects reflect these goals and demonstrate outcomes toward accomplishing them.

Funds in the amount of \$1,790,789, have been allocated from the following sources:

No matching funds are required as condition to receive grant funding. Grant funds will be used for personnel, contracted services, educational materials, supplies, computer software, and hardware.

Official notification of the grant awards is anticipated on or before September 30, 2008, which is after the start of the grant period. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective July 1, 2008.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- accept three grant awards from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding the Florida Diagnostic and Learning Resources System (FDLRS-South) under:
  - a. Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), Part B, in the approximate amount of \$ 1,411,762, for the grant period of July 1, 2008, through August 31, 2009;
  - b. IDEA, Part B, Preschool, in the approximate amount of \$270,468, for the grant period of July 1, 2008, through August 31, 2009; and
  - c. General Revenue, in the approximate amount of \$107,085, for the grant period of July 1, 2008, through June 30, 2009; for a total approximate amount of \$1,789,315;
- 2. retain funds from the grants in an amount not to exceed the annually negotiated indirect cost rate, as allowed and approved by the FLDOE;
- 3. enter into a contractual agreement to provide services to The School Board of Monroe County, Florida, in an amount not to exceed \$181,000, for the grant period effective from July 1, 2008, through August 31, 2009;
- 4. extend these programs and contractual agreement, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the programs; and
- 5. direct Financial Operations to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
