The above agencies sponsor after school programs for Miami-Dade County Public Schools students. Staff from the approved agency will pick up the requested number of snacks daily from the school food service manager at the assigned school location. The agencies will be billed \$0.75 per snack. The school food service manager maintains daily billing records for the snacks served to the approved agencies and the School Food Service Accounting Department provides monthly billings to the agencies for the total number of snacks sold.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent of Schools to enter into contractual agreements with various agencies, for the Department of Food and Nutrition to provide snacks for participants in their after school programs from August 21, 2008, through August 20, 2009.

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
