On January 7, 2009, the following letter was sent to Mr. Reginald T. Everson:

This is to notify you that the Superintendent of Schools will be recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of January 14, 2009, that the School Board suspend you without pay from your current position as Custodian at Citrus Grove Elementary School, for 30 calendar days, effective at the close of the workday, January 14, 2009, for just cause, including, but not limited to: violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13- 4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties; 6Gx13- 4A-1.213, Code of Ethics; and 6Gx13- 4A-1.302, Separation-Dismissal or Suspension-All Personnel (weapons). This action is taken in accordance with Sections 1001.32(2), 1012.22(1)(f), 1012.40 and 447.209, Florida Statutes; and Articles II and XI of the **Contract between the Miami-Dade County Public Schools and the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees (AFSCME)**.

You have waived, in writing, your right to an administrative hearing and grievance/arbitration process.

If the School Board accepts (or approves) the Superintendent's recommendation, you will be notified of the School Board's action.

RECOMMENDED: That effective January 14, 2009, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend Mr. Reginald T. Everson, Custodian at Citrus Grove Elementary School, for 30 calendar days without pay.
