The Superintendent of Schools requests authorization to renew contractual agreements with the following agencies for the Department of Food and Nutrition to provide snacks for participants in their after school programs in Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) facilities:

- Family Christian Association of America
- Metropolitan Miami-Dade County Community Action Agency Head Start
- Young Women's Christian Association of Greater Miami (YWCA)
- Young Men's Christian Association of Greater Miami (YMCA)
- Amigos for Kids, Inc.
- · Regis House, Inc.
- Youth Co-Op, Inc.
- Florida Educational Leadership Council (FELC)
- Cool Kids, Inc.
- Concerned African Women, Inc.
- Champion Learning, Inc.

The above agencies sponsor after school programs M-DCPS students. Staff from the approved agency will pick up the requested number of snacks daily from the school food service manager at the assigned school location. The agencies will be billed \$0.75 per snack, which covers all costs to provide the service. The school food service manager maintains daily billing records for the snacks served to the approved agencies and the School Food Service Accounting Department provides monthly billings to the agencies for the total number of snacks sold.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent of Schools to enter into contractual agreements with various agencies, for the Department of Food and Nutrition to provide snacks for participants in their after school programs from August 24, 2009, through August 23, 2010.
