STRATEGIC PLAN: IMPROVE SAFETY AND THE SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT

On September 18, 2009, the Superintendent of Schools held a press conference, attended by numerous community leaders and the State Attorney's Office, at which time he unveiled a set of initiatives meant to prevent and address the problem of violence in the community.
