The Superintendent of Schools requests authorization to enter into contractual agreements with The City of Hialeah, by and through Education and Community Services Department, and St. Thomas University, for the Department of Food and Nutrition to provide snacks for participants in their after school programs in Miami-Dade County Public Schools facilities.

The above agencies sponsor after school programs for Miami-Dade County Public Schools students. The school food service manager maintains daily billing records for the snacks served to the approved agencies and the School Food Service Accounting Department provides monthly billings to the agencies for the total number of snacks sold.

**RECOMMENDED:**     That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent of Schools, to enter into contractual agreements with the following entities:

1. The City of Hialeah, by and through Education and Community Services Department, for the Department of Food and Nutrition, to provide snacks for participants in their after school programs from March 18, 2010 through August 21, 2010; and
2. St. Thomas University, for the Department of Food and Nutrition, to provide snacks for participants in their after school programs from March 18, 2010 through August 21, 2010.
