He began his career with Miami-Dade County Public Schools in 1975 at Poinciana Park Elementary School. Over the years, he has taught at Gladeview and Robert E. Lee middle schools and he has spent the last 23 years teaching at Hialeah Miami-Lakes Senior High School.

Throughout his esteemed career, Mr. George and his students have received consistent Superior ratings at District and State Evaluations in concert, jazz and marching bands. The Hialeah-Miami Lakes Senior High band is a nine-time Grand Champion Distinction winner of the Fiesta-Val Competitions. In addition, he was the guest conductor of the Superintendent's Honor Band in 2009.

Mr. George is a shining example of perseverance and hard work. His personal credo of excellence through high expectations has spread to his students - three of his former students are band directors. Two are band directors in Miami-Dade public schools while another is the general manager of Yale bands.

Mr. George will not stay idle in retirement. He plans to adjudicate for Band Music Performance Assessments as well as consulting and judging competitions.
