Chapter 2010-152 Laws of Florida provides that school districts shall increase Workforce Education fees. The 2010-2011 fees comprise the required local effort for the adult vocational and adult general education programs that fall under the Workforce Development Education category.

2010-2011 Workforce Development Education Fee Schedule

<u>Category</u>	<u>Current Cost Per Contact Hour</u>	<u>Proposed Cost Per Contact Hour</u>
Resident Vocational Certificate	\$2.10	\$2.15
Non-Resident Vocational Certificate	8.42	8.62
Resident Adult General Education	1.03	1.05
Non-Resident Adult General Education	4.13	4.22

Section 1009.22, F.S., provides legislative policy for determining fees for Workforce Development programs. In addition, Section 1009.22 (5), F.S., provides that each school board may collect up to an additional 10 percent for financial aid purposes and authorizes school districts to increase the established workforce education resident and non-resident tuition fees. The cost per contact hour includes a base cost in addition to the 10 percent financial aid fee. The 2010-2011 proposed fees include those established fees plus the additional fee.

No local funds are required.

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RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida:

1. approve the 2010-2011 Workforce Development Education Program fee schedule; and
2. authorize the Superintendent to calculate and implement the 2010-2011 Revised Workforce Development Education fees.
