Miscellaneous Special Revenue consists of two funds: School Board Law Enforcement Trust Fund and School Board Special Events Trust Fund. This resolution represents the final budget review for these two funds.

SCHOOL BOARD LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND

The School Board Law Enforcement Trust Fund was established during 1997-98 when the School Police became involved in issuing traffic/parking citations and receiving forfeited property. Florida Statute 932.7055 (5g) requires that a school board security agency employing law enforcement officers deposit into this specific fund, the proceeds realized pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act.

Forfeited funds may not be used for normal operating expenses of the law enforcement agency. Proceeds and interest shall be used for school resource officers, crime prevention, safe neighborhood, drug abuse education and prevention programs or other law enforcement purposes.

Florida Statues 938.15 allows municipalities and counties to assess an additional \$2 for traffic/parking citations to be used for expenditures for criminal justice education degree programs and training courses including basic recruit training for their officers and employing agency support personnel; attendance to workshops, meetings, conferences and conventions approved by the Commissioner for the agency.

This resolution increases revenues, appropriations and ending fund balance by \$97,408 in the School Board Law Enforcement Trust Fund as shown on the attached schedule (page 3 of 4) to reflect actual FY2009-10 results.

SPECIAL EVENTS FUND

The Special Events Fund was established during the 1986-87 fiscal year to handle the external funding of community-related/special recognition activities which generate revenues from donations and/or sales of admission tickets. Generally, appropriations for an event are available to be expended only to the extent actual revenues have been received, unless otherwise approved by the School Board.

This resolution decreases revenues, appropriations and ending fund balance by (\$166,327) in the Special Events Funds as shown on the attached schedule (page 4 of 4) to reflect actual FY2009-10 results.

- 1.) adopt Resolution No. 1, the FY2009-10 Miscellaneous Special Revenue School Board Law Enforcement Trust Fund Final Budget Review, increasing revenues, appropriations and ending fund balance by \$97,408 as shown on the schedule on page 3 of 4; and
- 2.) adopt Resolution No. 1, the FY2009-10 Miscellaneous Special Revenue School Board Special Events Trust Fund Final Budget Review, reducing revenues, appropriations and ending fund balance by (\$166,327) as shown on the schedule on page 4 of 4.
