**SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION TO EXPLORE THE FEASIBILITY OF BOARD OPERATION OF ITS BOARD-OWNED PARKING LOTS IN THE GENERAL VICINITY OF THE SCHOOL BOARD ADMINISTRATION BUILDING (SBAB), AS A REVENUE GENERATION MEASURE**

**LINK TO STRATEGIC FRAMEWORK: FINANCIAL EFFICIENCY/STABILITY**

The School Board owns several parking facilities in the general area surrounding the SBAB. For the past three years, the Board has leased some of those facilities to the Miami Parking Authority (MPA) for use in connection with events at the Adrienne Arsht Center for the Performing Arts of Miami-Dade County (Arsht Center). Since the agreement with the MPA is under renegotiation for renewal, it would be both timely and appropriate to explore the viability and cost effectiveness of the Board assuming its operation of the parking facilities in connection with events at the Arsht Center and other opportunities. If approved by the Board, staff will undertake this review and report back to the Board by the November 16, 2010 meeting.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize exploring the feasibility of Board operation of its Board-owned parking facilities in the general vicinity of the SBAB, as a revenue generation measure.

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
