Over the past several months, there have been two incidents where pornographic or materials obscene in nature were discarded on Miami-Dade County Public Schools property.

Under current law, individuals engaged in this act can only be charged with trespassing, a second degree misdemeanor.

This resolution calls for the State of Florida legislature to make discarding pornographic or obscene materials in school zones of elementary schools, middle schools, and K-8 centers a more serious offense therefore imposing harsher penalties on those guilty of such an act.
