Section 1002.33(7), Florida Statutes, Charter Schools, stipulates that the major issues involved in the operation of charter schools be considered in advance and written into a charter school contractual agreement, between the charter school and the sponsor, following a public hearing to ensure community input. Additionally, a charter school contractual agreement may be modified during its initial term or any renewal term upon the recommendation of the sponsor and the approval of both parties to the agreement.

Pursuant to School Board Policy 9800, Charter Schools, the M-DCPS' Charter School Contract Review Committee (CRC) met to review the charter school contractual agreements delineated below and made recommendations for approval to the Superintendent of Schools

Initial Year Loss: The revenue and teaching positions indicated as "Initial Year Loss," provide an estimate of the potential impact to the District's General Fund (\$1,472,902) and instructional staffing (27 positions). The loss of revenue describes 95% of FEFP funds per student, based on 75% of the initial year's enrollment projection, which will not be realized by the District for the current fiscal year. The loss in teaching positions, based on average class size requirements, reflects the possible reduction in basic teaching positions resulting from the anticipated decrease in students.
