This lawsuit was served on the School Board on June 6, 2011 and on the individually named Defendant, Francois Emmanuel Carvil (a school bus driver), on April 26, 2011. The Complaint seeks relief, among other things, for injuries allegedly caused by Mr. Carvil during the course and scope of his employment.

In accordance with School Board Policy No. 6900 (*Legal Services for Employees of the Board*) and the authority vested under § 1012.26 Fla. Stat. (2010), the individually named Defendant, Francois Emmanuel Carvil, has formally requested that the School Board provide him with legal representation. We are requesting that the School Board authorize the provision of legal representation for Mr. Carvil in the above-referenced case. Mr. Carvil will be represented by counsel from the School Board Attorney's office. In the interim, the Board Attorney's office will be filing the necessary documents with the Court to protect the School Board's legal interests.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the office of the School Board Attorney to provide legal representation of School Board employee, Francois Emmanuel Carvil, the individually named defendant in the case *Enrique Carrillo*, et al v. Francois Emmanuel Carvil, individually, The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, Circuit Court Case No. 11-12773 CA 23.
