Currently, the School Board of Miami-Dade County has policies which prevent Board Members and District staff from lobbying or doing business with the school system. This policy is meant to prevent policy makers and administrators from favoring their personal interest over those of the district.

In the interest of transparency and integrity, the Miami-Dade County School Board should not permit individuals who are registered lobbyists with Miami-Dade County School Board to be appointed to any Miami Dade County School Board Advisory Committees.

ACTION PROPOSED BY MR. CARLOS L. CURBELO:

That the Miami-Dade County School Board amend board policy to disqualify any individual who is a registered lobbyist with the Miami-Dade County School Board from being appointed to any School Board Advisory Committees.
