This action is taken in accordance with Sections 1001.32(2), 1012.22(1)(f), 1012.33, and 447.209, Florida Statutes; and State Board Rules 6B-1.001, 6B-1.006, and 6B-4.009, FAC.

Robin M. Lockery: suspension without pay from her position as Speech Language Pathologist at James H. Bright/J.W. Johnson Elementary School and initiation of dismissal proceedings, effective February 16, 2012, for just cause, including, but not limited to: gross insubordination; incompetency due to inefficiency; and violation of School Board Policies 3210, Standards of Ethical Conduct; and 3210.01, Code of Ethics. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 1001.32(2), 1012.22(1)(f), 1012.33, and 447.209, Florida Statutes; and State Board Rules 6B-1.001, 6B-1.006, and 6B-4.009, FAC.
