Three days are required for this trip, none of which are school days. Travel will be provided by American Airlines.

The cost to each student will be for meals and incidentals. Two chaperones will travel with the group at a cost of \$75.00 for airport fees plus meals and incidentals.

Students will provide written reports to the principal summarizing the highlights, experiences and educational value of the trip. The reports will also be posted on the school's website for other students to review.
