A request has been received for students to travel out-of-country. All arrangements are in accordance with Board Policy 2340 - Field and Other District-Sponsored Trips and with School Board Policy 8640 – Transportation for Field and Other District-Sponsored Trips.

Sunset Senior High School	Malaga, Granada, Sevilla, Madrid and Barcelona, Spain	3/21/13 to 3/31/13	40	Expose students to real life experiences to hospitality topics covered in their Hospitality and Tourism Academy courses.

Ten days are required for this trip, none of which are school days. Travel will be provided by a major airline carrier such as American Airlines or Iberia.

The cost for the students traveling will be \$3,144.00 per student. Six chaperones will travel with the group at no cost since Educational Tours offers one free chaperone for every six participants.

The students and teachers participating in the trip will be registered with the U.S. Department of State by utilizing their on-line Smart Traveler Enrollment Program (STEP) which is a free service provided by the United States Government. By registering trip participants with STEP, the Department of State can better assist them in an emergency.

The cost for the student traveling will be \$2,500 per student. Six chaperones will travel with the group at no cost. Educational purposes for the trip are to provide a real life experience of inequality topics covered in their Academy courses.

The students and chaperones participating in the trip will be registered with the U.S. Department of State by utilizing the State Travel Registry (STR) which is a free service provided by the United States Government. By registering the participants with STR, the Department of State can monitor the safety of the students and chaperones.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, approve the out-of-country field trip to Spain for the students at Sunset Senior High School.
