A request has been received for students to travel out-of-country. All arrangements are in accordance with Board Policy 2340 - Field and Other District-Sponsored Trips and with School Board Policy 8640 – Transportation for Field and Other District-Sponsored Trips.

Holmes Braddock Senior High School	London, England, and Paris, France	3/21/13 to 3/29/13	42	Students in the Cambridge and IT Magnet programs will have an opportunity to bring the classroom to life. They'll be able to better understand the concepts learned in class by visiting monuments and famous memorials as well as experience first-hand new cultures and ways of life.

Seven days are required for this trip, none of which are school days. Travel will be provided by Delta Airlines.

The cost for the students traveling will be \$2,727.00 per student. Seven chaperones will travel with the group at no cost since Educational Tours offers one free chaperone for every six participants.

The students and teachers participating in the trip will be registered with the U.S. Department of State by utilizing their on-line Smart Traveler Enrollment Program (STEP) which is a free service provided by the United States Government. By registering trip participants with STEP, the Department of State can better assist them in an emergency.

The students will provide a written report to the principal summarizing the highlights, experiences and educational value of the trip. The reports will also be posted on the school's website for other students to review.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, approve the out-of-country field trip to England and France for the students at G. Holmes Braddock Senior High School.
