On Wednesday, March 20th, 2013, a group of young professionals from the Greater Miami Chamber of Commerce's Leadership Miami program hosted the first bullying awareness art and film festival for high school students in Miami-Dade. The event, titled: 'Bully Free-0-Five Art & Film Festival', included an exhibit of student artwork, music and dance performances, special guest speakers, and an awards show to celebrate the winning works of art. The event, which took place at Miami Jackson Senior High School, showcased over 220 works of art (including videos) submitted by more than 430 high school students across over 30 schools in Miami-Dade.

The first place award at the festival went to Miami Springs Senior High School sophomores Jennifer Porres and Daniela Zapata for their video 'Take a Stand, Lend a Hand'. Jennifer and Daniela not only came up with the concept for the winning video. they also directed and produced the film, and recruited fellow classmates to participate. Rather than merely illustrating the definition of bullying, Porres and Zapata instead conceptualized a proactive approach to the issue - calling on others to take action.

With unbridled creativity, and the guidance of their teacher, Mr. Rene Barge, Jennifer and Daniela were able to create a truly impactful video that serves as moving call to action in the fight against bullying. In the end, their talent and creativity also paid off for their school, which received a \$5,000 donation from the festival organizers for being home to the winning first place entry.
