The students and teachers participating in the trip will be registered with the U.S. Department of State by utilizing their on-line Smart Traveler Enrollment Program (STEP) which is a free service provided by the United States Government. By registering trip participants with STEP, the Department of State can better assist them in an emergency.

The students will provide a written report to their respective principal summarizing the highlights, experiences and educational value of the trip. The reports will also be posted on the schools' website for other students to review.

2. England and Ireland for the students at Jorge Mas Canosa Middle School;

4. France and Italy for the students at Felix Varela Senior High School;
5. Germany, Czech Republic, Poland, and Hungary for the students at MAST Academy;
6. France for the students at Palmetto Middle School;
7. France for the students at New World School of the Arts;
8. England and Ireland for the students at Alonzo and Tracy Mourning Senior High School;
9. Germany, Czech Republic, Hungary and Austria for the students at Miami Beach Senior High School.

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
