Miscellaneous Special Revenue consists of two funds: School Board Law Enforcement Trust Fund and School Board Special Events Trust Fund. This resolution represents the first resolution for the School Board Law Enforcement Trust Fund. The Special Events Funds does not need to be updated at this point.

SCHOOL BOARD LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND

The School Board Law Enforcement Trust Fund was established during 1997-98 when the School Police became involved in issuing traffic/parking citations and receiving forfeited property. Florida Statute 932.7055 (5g) requires that a school board security agency employing law enforcement officers deposit into this specific fund, the proceeds realized pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act.

Forfeited funds may not be used for normal operating expenses of the law enforcement agency. Proceeds and interest shall be used for school resource officers, crime prevention, safe neighborhood, drug abuse education and prevention programs or other law enforcement purposes.

Florida Statues 938.15 allows municipalities and counties to assess an additional \$2 for traffic/parking citations to be used for expenditures for criminal justice education degree programs and training courses including basic recruit training for their officers and employing agency support personnel; attendance to workshops, meetings, conferences and conventions approved by the Commissioner for the agency.

This resolution decreases revenues, appropriations and ending fund balance by \$135,934 in the School Board Law Enforcement Trust Fund as shown on the attached schedule (page 3 of 3) to reflect actual FY 2013-14 results.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida: Adopt Resolution No. 1, the FY 2013-14 Miscellaneous Special Revenue — School Board Law Enforcement Trust Fund — Spring Budget Review, decreasing revenues, appropriations and ending fund balance by \$135,934 as shown on the schedule on page 3 of 3.
