The Florida Department of Education has provided information that Workforce Education tuition rates are to be the same as the 2013-2014 rates. House Bill 851 has eliminated the fee for the Non-Resident Adult General Education category. These fees comprise the required local effort for the postsecondary vocational and adult general education programs that fall under the Workforce Development Education category.

**Workforce Development Education Fee Schedule**

Resident Vocational Certificate	\$2.56 Per Hour	\$2.56 Per Hour
Non-Resident Vocational Certificate	\$10.25 Per Hour	\$10.25 Per Hour
Resident Adult General Education	\$30.00 Per Term	\$30.00 Per Term
Non-Resident Adult General Education	\$120.00 Per Term	N/A

Section 1009.22, F.S., provides legislative policy for determining fees for Workforce Development programs. In addition, Section 1009.22 (5), F.S., provides that each school board may collect up to an additional 10 percent for financial aid purposes and requires school districts to increase the established workforce education resident and non-resident tuition fees which is included in the above rate.

No local funds are required.
