The Superintendent of Schools has recommended that these students be expelled from the regular and adult programs of Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) and assigned to alternative schools/programs for the maximum time permitted under Board policy, which commenced on the date of the incidents giving rise to the expulsions during the 2013-2014 school year and ends at the conclusion of the 2014-2015 school year.

The parents have been duly notified of the recommendation for expulsion and were given an opportunity for a conference with staff and were advised of the right to a hearing before an impartial hearing examiner.

The basis for this recommendation is as follows:

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida:

- expel the student specified in supplemental material SM-33 furnished under separate cover to School Board members, from the regular and adult programs of Miami-Dade County Public Schools and assign to alternative school/programs for the maximum time permitted under law, which commenced on the date of the incidents giving rise to the expulsions during the 2013-2014 school year and ends at the conclusion of the 2014-2015 school year;
- expel the student specified in supplemental material SM-36 furnished under separate cover to School Board members, from the regular and adult programs of Miami-Dade County Public Schools and assign to alternative school/programs for the maximum time permitted under law, which commenced on the date of the incidents giving rise to the expulsions during the 2013-2014 school year and ends at the conclusion of the 2014-2015 school year;
- 3. provide educational services in alternative school/programs during the term of the expulsion; and
- 4. following the term of the expulsions, permit the students to be returned to regular school programs in Miami-Dade County Public Schools, if approved by School Operations.
