“Miami Habla – Entrevistas a Hispanos Emblemáticos” is a joint research work done and dedicated by Adriana Bianco to the celebration of the 500 Anniversary of America’s discovery that provides an actual vision of Miami, considered by many as the capital city of the Hispanic world. The work involved interviews of 45 individuals representing 20 Latin American countries currently living in Miami who have become role models for the Hispanic community and the embodiment of the American Dream.

In addition to being a co-author of “Miami Habla – Entrevistas a Hispanos Emblemáticos,” with Rafael Cerrato, Adriana Bianco has been a child movie actress in Argentina with 7 movies to her credit earning her the Argentinian equivalent of an Oscar, the C ndor de Plata Award (Silver Condor). Ms. Bianco has been an equally prominent star of theater, radio, and television in South America as well as a reporter for Diario La Prensa in New York where she earned numerous professional awards. She has also taught at the Sorbonne in Paris, France, teaching Philosophy and Language Arts, been a certified Spanish teacher in both Brazil and Mexico and a Cultural Events Coordinator with the United States Information Services in Washington, D.C.

Adriana Bianco’s impressive professional credentials and her outstanding work in gathering the information and content for “Miami Habla – Entrevistas a Hispanos Emblemáticos” make her deserving of the recognition provided by this resolution.
