APPLICATIONS

Section 1002.33, F.S., authorizes the establishment of charter schools by individuals and/or organizations. As provided in Section 1002.33(6), F.S., and School Board Policy 9800, *Charter Schools*, Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) receives and reviews charter school applications for approval or denial by the School Board. Section 1002.33(6)(B)(3), F.S., requires School Boards to approve or deny the applications no later than 90 days after receipt, unless the applicant waives the deadline and an extension of time is then granted. This item recommends approval of five charter school applications received during the 2018 cycle. If these applications are approved, the earliest eligible opening would be for the 2019-2020 school year.

During the 2018 application cycle, a total of ten (10) applications were received, three applications have been withdrawn, two have been approved and the final five applications are being presented for consideration in this item.

APPLICATION EVALUATION

Pursuant to School Board Policy 9800, *Charter Schools*, the District reviews all applications using an evaluation instrument developed by the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) and may include additional information or documents requested by the District. The Standard Model Application includes standards of evaluation, certification and assurance declarations and an Application History Addendum. The Sponsor shall deny any application that does not comply with the State's statutory requirements and rules and/or Sponsor's instructions for charter school applications.

The Superintendent has appointed the Application Review Committee (ARC) with the responsibility to review and evaluate charter school applications after an initial technical review is conducted by staff. The ARC is comprised of representatives from various District departments and is charged with identifying strengths and deficiencies in the written application and/or areas that require clarification to fully evaluate the quality of the application or the capacity of the applicant to properly implement the proposed plan.

Pursuant to School Board Policy 9800, *Charter Schools*, five charter school applications are being presented for final consideration by the School Board. An overview of these charter school applications recommended for approval and the associated ARC recommendations is contained in the following table. Additional details of the applications can be found in Attachment "A", which is provided under separate cover but is included and incorporated by reference in this Board item. The application recommendations are as follows:

NEW AND AMENDED CHARTER SCHOOL CONTRACTS

Section 1002.33(7), F.S., states that the major issues involved in the operation of charter schools be considered in advance and written into a charter school contract between the charter school and the School Board following a public meeting. Pursuant to School Board Policy 9800, *Charter Schools*, six new charter contracts and ten (10) amended charter contracts are presented for consideration in this item. Additional details for the new charter school contracts recommended for approval can be found in Attachment "B", and additional details for the amended charter contracts can be found in Attachment "C". Recent changes in legislation also allow a high-performing charter school to increase enrollment beyond the contract capacity, but not to exceed the capacity of the facility at the time enrollment will take effect.

CHARTER SCHOOL CONTRACT RENEWALS

Section 1002.33(7)(b), F.S., states that a charter may be renewed provided that a program review demonstrates that the significant components of the charter application have been successfully accomplished and that none of the following grounds for nonrenewal/termination have been established: (1) failure to participate in the state's education accountability system or failure to meet the requirements for students performance stated in the charter; (2) failure to meet generally accepted standards of fiscal management; (3) violation of law; and/or (4) other good cause.

Additional details for each renewal contract can be found in Attachment "C", which is provided under separate cover but is included and incorporated by reference in this Board item. The recommendations for the twelve (12) charter school contract renewals included in this item are as follows:

CHARTER SCHOOL CONSOLIDATIONS

Section 1002.33(7)(b)(2)(c) states that a charter may be modified during its initial term or any renewal term upon the recommendation of the Sponsor or the charter school's governing board and the approval of both parties to the agreement. Modification may include, but is not limited to, consolidation of multiple charters into a single charter if the charters are operated under the same governing board and physically located on the same campus, regardless of the renewal cycle. All charter schools involved in these consolidations will be presented to the Florida Department of Education which will determine the surviving charter schools and associated Master School Identification Numbers. Pursuant to the state statute and during the renewal cycle, two charter school consolidations are being presented in this item for consideration. Additional details for these charter school consolidations can be found in Attachment "D", which is provided under separate cover but is included and incorporated by reference in this Board item:

DISTRICT IMPACT

Any significant increase in charter school student enrollment (Charter FTE) directly impacts the District's operating budget as well as instructional and non-instructional staffing levels. The new contracts being presented represent an increase in overall charter school enrollment and an anticipated initial loss to the District for the 2018-2019 SY.

To ensure that the District's financial position remains positive, Board authorization is requested to allow a Reduction-in-Force/Layoff only if it becomes necessary. Any such Reduction-in-Force/Layoff affecting instructional and non-instructional staff would be implemented in accordance with School Board policies and applicable collective bargaining agreements. The number of position reductions will not exceed the stated Initial Loss included in this item and will be re-evaluated and adjusted in subsequent years to reflect changes in FTE. Additional information on the impact is provided in Attachments "B", "C", and "D".

DUE PROCESS

To ensure proper notice and due process, the applicants and non-profit entities were noticed of the Superintendent's recommendation to the School Board and were provided a copy of the final evaluation and/or contract prior to the School Board Meeting. They were also informed of the School Board's Personnel, Student, School and Community Support Committee Meeting and procedures for requesting to appear before the School Board at meetings and public hearings.

Copies of the applications, application evaluations, and contracts have been transmitted to the School Board Members under separate cover and will be available for inspection by the public in the Office of Board Recording Secretary, Room 924, and in the Citizen Information Center, Room 158, 1450 N.E. Second Avenue, Miami, Florida 33132.

Board approval of this item does not reflect or constitute a finding of need, justification, or endorsement for any charter school as proposed in the item but only that it meets the statutory requirements for Board approval of a charter school application or contract under Section 1002.33, F.S., and School Board Policy, 9800, *Charter Schools*.
