Revised Excerpts from Unofficial Minutes of July 18, 2018 School Board Meeting

- 119,609 [A-2](#) **APPROVED***
1. Resolution 18-047, calling for a referendum to be held on November 6, 2018, for the purpose of seeking approval from the voters of Miami-Dade County for the School Board to levy an ad valorem assessment of 0.75 mills to ~~support teachers, instructional personnel and school safety and security~~ increase compensation for teachers and instructional personnel, and to enhance school safety and security personnel;
 2. in accordance with Section 1011.73(2), F.S., direct the Miami-Dade County Commission to place the referendum on the November 6, 2018, general election ballot as authorized by Resolution 18-047;
 3. authorized the Superintendent to use District resources to educate the community on the purpose and benefits of the proposed referendum; and
 4. authorized the Superintendent to develop a framework for the establishment of a citizen oversight advisory committee, to be approved by the Board at the August 15, 2018, School Board meeting, for the purpose of monitoring the use of proceeds generated by the passage of the referendum proposed under Resolution 18-047 and present a recommendation to the Board by August 2018.
