Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) requires that schools develop and implement a School Improvement Plan (SIP). These plans include specific strategies to improve school culture, academic performance, and address educational priorities.

In order to ensure schools are developing relevant and meaningful School Improvement Plans, M-DCPS has launched a new School Improvement Platform for all traditional K-12 schools. Adult, vocational, and alternative centers as well as select charter schools will continue to use the Florida Bureau of School Improvement's online SIP template.

This initiative (Success by Design) will be implemented in four phases throughout the school year ensuring schools are continuously defining their current reality and developing meaningful implementation steps to address improvement priorities within their SIPs. The four phases of Success by Design are:

- Data Analysis, July 11, 2018 July 27, 2018
- Action Planning, August 16, 2018 December 21, 2018
- Mid-Year Review, January 7, 2019 May 10, 2019
- End of Year Reflection, May 13, 2019 June 3, 2019

All SIPs were developed through a collegial consensus building process which included the District and Regions as well as approval by the Educational Excellence School Advisory Council (EESAC) and Region staff.
