The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, Educational Facilities Impact Fee Fund, Special-Purpose Financial Statements were audited by C Borders-Byrd, CPA, LLC. The auditor concluded that the special-purpose financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the Educational Facilities Impact Fee Fund as of June 30, 2018. This language constitutes an unmodified opinion, which is the highest opinion that can be assigned to a financial statement audit. No findings were reported.

Total revenues reported for the Educational Facilities Impact Fee Fund, Special-Purpose Financial Statements for fiscal year 2018 were \$23,045,732. This represented an increase of close to \$3 million when compared to total revenues of \$20,049,360 that were reported for fiscal year 2017.

For the year ended June 30, 2018, the Fund balance reported was \$28,723,449. This represented an increase of close to \$8 million when compared to the prior fiscal year Fund balance of \$20,803,517.

The School Board Audit and Budget Advisory Committee will review this report at its December 11, 2018, meeting to consider its transmission to the School Board.
