Background:

On November 25, 2019, a solicitation was published to competitively bid (Hard Bid) construction of the Myrtle Grove K-8 Center new addition project. Bids have been received and this item provides a recommendation for award to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

Twelve (12) pre-qualified contractors picked up plans and specifications. A mandatory prebid conference was conducted on December 11, 2019, for interested contractors and subcontractors. Five (5) sealed bids were received and these were opened on January 9, 2020, at the School Board Administration Building, Conference Room 559. The District staff from the Office of School Facilities, staff from Procurement Management Services and the Project Architect witnessed the bid opening.

After analysis of the bid tabulation (see Attachment A), it was determined that Mexal Corporation (Mexal) was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, with a Base Bid price of \$2,099,337.00. Additionally, the award amount is being reduced by \$41,986.74 as a result of sales tax savings generated by the District's Direct Materials Procurement Program. Consequently, District Staff and the Project Architect, Rodriguez Architects, Inc., recommend awarding the project to Mexal in the amount of \$2,057,350.26.

The contract provides for compliance with Small Business, Micro Business and Minority Owned Business Utilization Goals. The Office of School Facilities Construction staff reviewed the SBE, MBE and M/WBE certification status of all subcontractors and verified the existence of a Letter of Intent for each, outlining roles and responsibilities.

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Small/ Micro Business Utilization:

A mandatory S/MBE participation goal of 19.92% for Construction was established for this project (as determined by the M-DCPS Goal Setting Committee). Identified below are the S/MBE firms that Mexal will use on the project.

Minority/Women Business Enterprise Utilization:

A mandatory M/WBE participation goal of 5.08%; encompassing African American, Native American and Asian American firms; was established for this project (as determined by the M-DCPS Goal Setting Committee).

Identified below are the S/MBE and M/WBE firms that Mexal will use on the project. Additional S/MBE and/or M/WBE subcontractors may be included in the project as the contractor finalizes awarding of all the subcontracts.

<u>Description and Scope</u>

Myrtle Grove K-8 Center is located at 3125 N.W. 176 Street, Miami Gardens, Florida 33056. The site is bordered on the north by Myrtle Grove Park and the North Miami Beach Sewer Division, on the east by N.W. 29 Court, on the west by a residential neighborhood and on the south by N.W. 176 Street. The existing school was built in 1956, with additions constructed afterwards, and is currently comprised of 10 permanent buildings situated on an approximately 9-acre parcel of land. The facility has a permanent capacity of 680 student stations and will expand to a total capacity of 740 permanent student stations upon completion.

Project Scope:

The proposed scope of work for this project includes but is not limited to: a new approximately 4,809 square foot building addition to include a music suite, art suite, new covered walk to existing campus, mechanical room, electrical room, and an I.T. room. The art portion of the building will house a 2D/3D art lab, kiln and large art material storage area, and an outdoor art patio. The music area of the building will include a band classroom, instrument storage room.
