The rapid spread of Coronavirus is very dangerous on many levels. The virus has caused numerous deaths and illnesses and has virtually shut down infected areas. A top priority of Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) is to protect our students, faculty, and community. Therefore, it is our responsibility to have a thorough preventative plan, and an action plan to address any infection in M-DCPS in the event the virus in contracted in this District. A plan should the virus be detected must specify what actions need to be taken to test and isolate those who come in contact with a carrier of the virus.

This item requests that the Superintendent leads the effort in conducting meetings with various health and government agencies to prepare for potential scenarios dealing with the Coronavirus. Some areas the plan should address is testing and isolation for the following situations if:

- 1. Students have traveled to infected areas:
- 2. A case is found in our schools or in any District facility and newly established protocols are relied upon for those who are potentially at-risk;
- 3. M-DCPS cannot verify locations where newly registered students have visited or lived in the past month.
