The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, announced on April 15, 2015, its intention to amend School Board Policy *5120, Assignment Within District*, at its meeting of June 17, 2015.

The Attendance Boundary Committee is recommending the following:

- Establish new attendance boundaries for Riverside Elementary Community School and Citrus Grove Elementary School.
- Establish new attendance boundaries for Coral Gables Preparatory Academy, George W. Carver Elementary School and Sunset Elementary School. These schools will no longer serve as Controlled Choice schools. For the 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 School Years, eligible students living within the Coral Gables Preparatory Academy and the George W. Carver Elementary School attendance boundaries will collectively have priority for up to 50% of in-boundary magnet seats. The balance of in-boundary seats will be students living within the Sunset Elementary School attendance boundary. At the end of this time period, district staff will review the impact of this decision and will advise the Superintendent as to the continuation of this policy.
- Establish new attendance boundaries for Booker T. Washington Senior High School and Miami Jackson Senior High School.
- Establish new attendance boundaries for Colonial Drive Elementary School, Pine Lake Elementary School, and Robert Russa Moton Elementary School.
- Establish new attendance boundaries for Paul W. Bell Middle School.
- Establish new attendance boundaries for Miami Arts Studio 6-12 @ Zelda Glazer.

The Notice of Intended Action was published in the *Miami Daily Business Review* on April 20, 2015, posted in various places for public information and mailed to various organizations representing persons affected by the amended policy and to individuals requesting notification.

The time to request a hearing or protest the adoption of this policy has elapsed.

In accordance with provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act, this amended policy is presented to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, for adoption and authorization to file the policy in the official records of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

Attached is the Notice of Intended Action and the policy proposed for amendment. Changes from the current policy are indicated by <u>underscoring</u> words to be added and <u>striking through</u> words to be deleted.
