SUBJECT: TEACHER AIDE FOR BASIC SKILLS (TABS)

In 1990 the Teacher's Aid for Basic Skills (TABS) was put in elementary schools to provide schools with a way to measure the mastery of students' skills in Reading and Math. This application was used on personal computers running on DOS operating systems and required software for the different Reading and Math programs. As technology progressed, computers were replaced with operating systems that were not compatible with the TABS program. In addition, the Reading and Math programs software have not been updated since 1996. For these reasons, the TABS program has become obsolete and is no longer supported.

NOTE: The Demographic Download file, also known as the TABS download, is still available. The Demographic Download file (Student.dat) contains students' demographic information that is created for downloading into programs such as Excel or other spreadsheet software.

As an alternative to the TABS program, Miami-Dade County Public Schools offers programs that provide similar services.

- Assess2Learn is an Online Assessment tool that offers an assortment of FCAT preparation test and allows teachers to create their own online tests.
