Volunteering in Miami-Dade County Public Schools is as easy as 1-2-3!

Persons interested in volunteering must:

- 1. Register at the school site of your choice.
- 2. Successfully complete a background check. (at no cost to the volunteer)
- 3. Attend an orientation meeting once you have been contacted that you are approved to volunteer.

Volunteers who wish to perform one of the following duties at the school must receive a fingerprint background check.

- Chaperone on overnight field trips
- Assist with athletic events or in physical education classes
- Mentor a student
- Become a Listener/Oyente
- Become a Certified Volunteer

For all other volunteering duties, the person will adhere to the same steps as stated above and the background check is conducted electronically rather than a fingerprint check.

<u>Please note:</u> The fingerprinting technicians need to adhere to this schedule; therefore if you want to ensure that your fingerprints are taken, please arrive early and not a few minutes prior to closing time. Chances are there already will be people in line waiting.

For your convenience: On Tuesdays and Thursdays, the fingerprinting mobile unit will come to any school that has 15 or more volunteers needing fingerprinting. Just call 305-986-8669 to schedule a block of time.

The Fingerprinting Office in the 1500 Biscayne Boulevard District office is *still* an option open to *any* volunteers who wish to come downtown. For an appointment call 305-995-7472.

Whether you are going to the district office, a region office or a school site, the following is still required:

- ✓ Original letter requesting fingerprints (signed by school site administrator in blue ink)
- ✓ Photo ID
- ✓ Proof of Social Security Number
