

For a number of years, the Florida Legislature has authorized sales-tax-free days for basic school supplies in advance of the opening of a new school year. The 2015 sales tax holiday is a 10-day event and will begin at 12:01 a.m., Friday, August 7th and end at midnight Sunday, August 16th. No Florida sales tax or local option tax will be collected during this time on sales of clothing, footwear, and certain accessories selling for \$100 or less per item, on certain school supplies selling for \$15 or less per item, and on computers and certain related accessories selling for the first \$750 of the sales price when purchased for noncommercial home or personal use.
