**M-DCPS ENCOURAGES PARENTS TO TAKE STATE'S ANNUAL

MIAMI - Miami-Dade County Public Schools' Division of Special Education is asking all parents of students, who receive special education services in Pre-K through 12th grade, to participate in the Florida Department of Education's annual Exceptional Student Education (ESE) Parent Survey.
