On Wednesday, May 24th, the Argentine Navy's training ship Libertad will dock on Miami shores, as part of a 197-day voyage that includes calls at ports in fifteen European countries and in the US, including Charleston and Miami.

On the Week of Argentina's National Celebrations, the visit of the tall ship "ARA" Libertad is a significant gesture of the consolidation of Argentina's presence in the ports it calls, demonstrating our country's clear opening to the world.

The Frigate Libertad is a symbol of the country and its culture, together with the desire to establish bonds of friendship with the peoples of the world. From March 25th to October 7th, the itinerary of the crew of 297, includes ports in Brazil, United States, Sweden, France, England, Spain, Brazil and Uruguay.

During its visit to the Miami, the general public can board and visit the tall museum ship on the following dates and times:
