SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY (FSU) FOR FUNDING THE FSU TEACHER ENHANCEMENT DISTANCE LEARNING PROGRAM, JUNE 15, 1999 – AUGUST 15, 2000

Florida State University (FSU) is implementing a comprehensive mathematics and science advanced degree program for elementary and middle school teachers in Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS). This collaboration between M-DCPS and FSU is offering a distance learning program that incorporates technology as a tool for delivery of the curriculum. The program provides participants the opportunity to complete a masters or an educational specialist degree in Science Education, Mathematics Education, or Mathematics and Science Education from Florida State University.

Grant funds, in the amount of \$43,000, will provide for an Educational Specialist who will facilitate implementation of the FSU Teacher Enhancement Distance Learning Program.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award from Florida State University, in the amount of \$43,000, for funding the FSU Teacher Enhancement Distance Learning Program, June 15, 1999 – August 15, 2000; and
2. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
