SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT GRANT AWARDS ON AN ON-GOING BASIS FROM THE PILLSBURY COMPANY FOUNDATION TO IMPROVE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT, JULY 15, 1999 – JUNE 30, 2000

**STRATEGIC PLANNING GOALS: II - STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT/PREPARATION FOR POST-SECONDARY EXPERIENCES
III - READING/LANGUAGE ARTS**

M. A. Milam Elementary School has been awarded a grant, in the amount of \$7,000 from the Pillsbury Company Foundation. The project is designed to provide tutoring in the subjects of reading and mathematics for at-risk students. Funds in the amount of \$7,000 will provide before and/or after school tutoring.

The program will provide targeted students with much needed attention to improve reading comprehension and mathematics computation for at-risk students. All schools were invited to participate in this grant initiative via the Federal Programs and Grants Administration web page.

The Pillsbury Company Foundation awards grants up to a maximum amount of \$10,000 on an on-going basis throughout the school year. Therefore, it is being requested that the Superintendent accept the awards on an on-going basis through June 30, 2000.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept grant awards on an on-going basis from The Pillsbury Company Foundation to improve student achievement, July 15, 1999 – June 30, 2000; and
2. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the Pillsbury Company Foundation; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
