This supplemental award is requested due to increased usage of frozen pizza and pasta products by the school and students, which has been caused, in part, by problems with the existing food jobbers' delivery of other menu food items. Pizza was offered more often on the weekly menu to accommodate student needs. Last contract usage averaged \$14,035.64 per month, while this year's usage has averaged \$21,825.53 per month. At the time the last supplement was requested, there was a substantial expenditure amount not included, due to invoices not being received and included in the calculation of actual expenditures. The supplemental amount requested is based on the average monthly expenditure amount, times the twelve (12) month contract period, minus the original award and supplemental amount.
