SUBJECT: PRE-QUALIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS FOR EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES CONSTRUCTION

On December 9, 1998, The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida adopted School Board Rule 6Gx13-<u>7D-1.05</u>, Pre-Qualification of Contractors for Educational Facilities Construction. This rule was created pursuant to Section 235.31 of the Florida Statutes and State Requirements for Educational Facilities (1997), which require school districts to prequalify contractors prior to their bidding on school work. This new law became effective July 1, 1998.

The following contractors have submitted all required information and are being recommended for pre-qualification.
