**SUBJECT: APPOINT AND ASSIGN:
ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEER**

The following recommendation is made in accordance with the Miami-Dade County Public Schools/Dade County Schools Administrators' Association labor contract.

This open budgeted position is due to the restructuring of the Bureau of Facilities Operations approved by the Board at its meeting of April 14, 1999, Agenda Item E-3.

Mr. Claudius A. Carnegie, currently a Coordinator, Construction Maintenance, pay grade 40, Bureau of Facilities Operations, is recommended for appointment to the open, budgeted position of Environmental Engineer, pay grade 44, Bureau of Facilities Operations. Mr. Carnegie received a Bachelor of Science Degree from Loughborough University of Technology, Leicestershire, United Kingdom, and a Master of Engineering Degree from Carleton University, Ottawa, Ontario, Canada. From 1987 to 1995, Mr. Carnegie served as President and Chief Engineer, Claudius A. Carnegie & Associates, Inc., Dallas, Texas. Since 1995 to the present, Mr. Carnegie has been employed by Miami-Dade County Public Schools as a Coordinator, Construction Maintenance, his current position.

This recommendation is the direct result of the Board-approved advertisement and selection process.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, appoint Mr. Claudius A. Carnegie, currently a Coordinator, Construction Maintenance, pay grade 40, to the open budgeted position of Environmental Engineer, pay grade 44, 12 months, and assign to the Bureau of Facilities Operations, effective July 15, 1999, or as soon thereafter as can be facilitated.
