On June 30, 1999, the Superintendent of Schools sent the following letter to Mr. Hector Perez:

I am exercising my responsibility as Superintendent of Schools and recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of July 14, 1999, that the School Board suspend you and initiate dismissal proceedings against you from your current position as Teacher at G.W. Carver Middle School, effective at the close of the workday, July 14, 1999, for misconduct in office, violation of School Board Rule 6Gx13-4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties, and conviction of a crime involving moral turpitude, upon such conviction. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 230.03(2), 230.23(5)(f), 231.36(1)(a), 231.36(6)(a), and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

If you wish to contest your suspension and dismissal, you must request a hearing in writing within 15 calendar days of the receipt of notice of the Board action, in which case, formal charges will be filed and a hearing will be held before an administrative law judge.

RECOMMENDED: That effective July 14, 1999, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend and initiate dismissal proceedings against Mr. Hector Perez, Teacher at G.W. Carver Middle School, pending the outcome of a hearing, if requested.
